

**MONITORING WELL(S) AND/ OR GEO-PROBE(S) ADDENDUM
APPLICATION FOR ROAD OPENING PERMIT FOR THE
COUNTY OF ESSEX**

1. The location of the proposed monitoring well(s) and/or GEO-Probe(s) shall be shown on a site plan at a scale of one (1) inch equals fifty (50) feet minimum.
2. The construction detail of the monitoring well(s) and/or GEO-Probe(s) shall be provided.
3. The permit for the installation of the monitoring well(s) expires six (6) months from the date of the issuance; the permit must be updated at the time of expiration.
4. Permittee, its employees, agents and contractors, further agree to indemnify, hold harmless, defend and pay on behalf of the County, its employees, agents, and invites any and all costs which may result from any and all claims for personal injury resulting from the installation, sampling, removal, and restoration work performed by Permittee, its employees, agents and contractor under this Agreement, including death and/or property damage arising from all acts or omissions of Permittee, its employees, agents, and contractors, including reasonable attorney's fees engendered thereby.
5. Permittee, in the sole discretion of the county, may be required to furnish a performance/maintenance guarantee in the form of a certified check prior to commencement of the work. The amount of the guarantee shall be as set by the County Engineer and/or duly authorized representative but not less than five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00).
6. The Permittee will provide an estimated construction cost, signed and sealed by a professional engineer, to the County Engineer and/or duly authorized representative for approval. The estimated costs of the removal and restoration work approved by the County Engineer and/or duly authorized representative will determine the amount of the guarantee.
7. Permittee, its employee's agents and contractors, shall maintain combined single limit insurance of at least \$2,000,000.00 including contractual liability coverage for independent contractors, and explosion, collapse and underground coverage. Said insurance shall remain in effect until one (1) year after completion of the restoration work to the satisfaction of the County Engineer and/or his duly authorized representative. Permittee, its employees, agents and /or contractors, shall also name the county as an additional insured in any such policy of insurance thereof and shall provide the county with a Certificate of Insurance as evidence of said policy upon execution of this Agreement, or within thirty (30) days thereafter. The providing of a Certificate of Insurance by Permittee naming the County as additional insured shall be deemed as a prerequisite to the continuation of any activity on county property by Insurance shall state that the County is named as an additional insured for liability coverage only.
8. The Office of County Engineer-Permits Section must be notified 24 hours in advance of starting work by calling at (973)226-8500, extension 2480. The permit becomes null and void unless work is started within thirty (30) days of date of issuance or unless a written request for extension is made by the Permittee. In no event there will be more than one (1) thirty (30) day extension be granted.
