



Essex County Mosquito Larvicides Spraying Notice

May 18, 2019

Due to the large amount of rain we received over the last few weeks, the County will be partnering with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) Office of Mosquito Control Coordination conducting an aerial larval control operation using granular BTI, on Tuesday May 21, 2019. This operation is contingent on favorable weather. This will start from 6:00 AM in the morning till 8:00 PM at night. We will be treating the waters along the Passaic River floodplains in the West Essex Towns Fairfield, West Caldwell, Roseland, Millburn, and Livingston. Residents may see low flying helicopter spraying granules from the sides of the copter. The helicopter will be operating from Essex County Airport in Fairfield. These granules we use are naturally occurring larvicides and harmless to humans and animals and residents should not be concerned about them.
